

Important Attention Points while Submitting Proposal:

Point 1: Applicant must have a valid TP registration on Skill India Portal. Submit proof in support of deemed ready status of TP Registration. TP Registration has to follow Accreditation & Affiliation (A&A) rules.

Point 2: Applicant to ensure that they fulfil the eligibility conditions for affiliation available at <https://texskill.in/training-partners/get-affiliated-as-training-partners/>. Depending on the job roles eligibility conditions are given below for easy reference.

A. Mill Sector Job Role ([Annexure-I Mill Sector Job Roles](#)):

- Textile Mill in running production
- Textile Mill machinery manufacturers including Technical Textile Mill machinery manufacturers
- State/Central government recognized Textile Mill organizations
- Registered Textile Mill industry associations in existence for past three years
- UGC/AICTE recognized institutes offering Textile Mill programs

B. Handloom Sector Job Role ([Annexure-II Handloom Sector Job Roles](#))

- Registered organizations engaged in manufacturing/marketing/training of handloom products inexistence for past three years
- State/Central government recognized Textile Mill organizations
- Registered Textile Mill industry associations in existence for past three years
- UGC/AICTE recognized institutes offering Textile Mill programs.

Point 3: Once above is ensured, then submit the evidence in support of those including infrastructure and equipment specific to the job roles.

Point 4: Letter or email as mark of endorsement for the job role applied from the concerned district authority responsible for skill development, such as, State Skill Development Mission, District authority etc. Please refer to Point C-e of RFPs.

Point 5: Details in the excel sheet must be strictly as per the template mentioned in the respective RFP. Any information in distorted form would be summarily rejected.
